All teams must supply water barrels or concrete to tie down awnings and structures, no stakes may be used to tie down structures. Teams will be liable to damage to the paddock from stakes or structures tied down inappropriately

advised of all spills. All fuel containers, and tires must be removed from the facility. Teams found not complying with this policy may be fined
