MotoAmerica - Twins Cup. Hooligans Brake System-Requirements

- 1. A Twins Brake System must be nominated and sent for approval by the manufacturer no later than January 31, 2025 and be made available to the public worldwide by February 16, 2025 through all approved dealers.
- 2. For the brake system to be approved the retail price must be equal to or less than:

a. **Twins Cup:** \$2300 (tax excluded) for a complete front or rear brake system. System mustinclude a master cylinder, calipers and any hardware required to operate the system. (Brake lines, brake pads and rotors are not included in price)

b. See FIMNA/MotoAmerica eligibility list for front and rear master cylinder list.

c. **Twins Cup:** \$800 (tax excluded) for a single caliper for the front or rear braking system. *Thebrake system and additional required parts must be individually priced and available separately.*

d. **Hooligans:** \$1800 (tax excluded) for a single caliper for the front, \$900 rear brake caliper. *Thebrake system and additional required parts must be individually priced and available separately.*

- 3. The manufacturers are allowed to offer service contracts when the team is using the approved and listed products. The manufacturers cannot demand a service contract for a customer or participant in order to obtain any product.
- 4. Manufacturers must supply MotoAmerica with documentation that details all of the components that will be offered. Details must include:
 - a. Price of each part.
 - b. Availability of parts (with lead time).
 - c. Diagram or illustration of the parts including identifying marks or serial number range.
- 5. The information must arrive at MotoAmerica by January 31 of the season in order that the last approved list can be made available to the teams no later than the February 15 of the racing season.
- 6. Final approval is upon discretion of MotoAmerica Technical Director.
